



2017 LEADERS IN LIFE YOUTH CONFERENCE INTENT TO PARTICIPATE

Dear School Principal/Representative or Youth Agency Representative,

We are inviting you and your students to participate in the 18th annual **Leaders in Life Youth Conference**, which will be held on **Thursday, March 9, 2017**, from **8:30 a.m. to 2:15 p.m.**, at the Rabobank Convention Center/Marriott Bakersfield. The purpose of this event is to give our local youth a positive environment to discuss and evaluate issues they face daily. These issues will be addressed in workshop sessions throughout the day by adult and youth facilitators with expertise in each topic of discussion. Sample topics include youth mentoring programs, college information and applications, relationships, self-esteem, stress management, conflict mediation, bullying prevention, and school safety.

The conference, **planned by teens for teens**, is open to middle school and high school students in 6th-12th grades. Participants will hear a nationally-recognized keynote speaker, attend two workshops on teen issues and gain information on matters important to them during the resource fair. **We invite you to send a maximum of 40 students, per school, to the conference. PLEASE NOTE: The conference has filled to capacity the past two years; schools must adhere to the 40-student limit.** All registered participants will be provided lunch and a conference t-shirt.

We strongly encourage you to send students and youth who can most appreciate and benefit from attending a conference focused on youth issues they may be dealing with. The students you select should represent **diverse backgrounds, diverse academic achievement levels, as well as cultural and ethnic diversity**. We will be prepared to make accommodations for special needs students and encourage you to include them in your delegation.

Again this year, we are offering a special track devoted to leadership and designed specifically for ASB, CASC and other student leaders. You may wish to have one group of students in this category as part of your contingent.

We also will offer one or more workshops designed to help schools address the LCAP requirement to get student input on the school climate elements of the Local Control Accountability Plan and will have a panel of youth and local administrators to provide a structured opportunity for students to share their ideas.

Thanks to the Leaders in Life Youth Conference Planning Committee and the support and contributions from local businesses and individuals, we are able to bring you this event at a phenomenal rate. **The registration fee is \$20.00 per person (students and adult chaperones) if your Intent to Participate is received by Monday, February 6, 2017. The fee will increase after that date.** Also, remember that **your school or agency is responsible for paying and arranging for transportation to and from the conference, as well as providing adult chaperones/advisors at a required student to adult ratio of 10:1.** Please feel free to encourage parents/guardians to help serve as **chaperones/advisors**. The school or agency bears complete responsibility for each student they bring to the Leaders in Life Youth Conference. Students are not to be left unattended at any time.
